Monthly Recovery Charges

Fixed Capital/Maintenance Recovery charges apply to ALL Property Owners within the District's boundary, regardless of whether water delivery service is provided.

- Fixed Capital Recovery Charge (USDA Debt Service) \$26
- Fixed Maintenance Recovery Charge (System Expenses) \$11
- Total Fixed Monthly Recovery Charge \$37^{and **}

Monthly Water Charges

Base Rate - Tier One: 0 – 7,500 gallons	\$6.00 *	\$24.50 **
Tier Two: 7,501 – 15,000 gallons	\$0.20/1,000 gallons	\$0.40/1,000 gallons
Tier Three: 15,001 – 114,800 gallons	\$0.50/1,000 gallons	\$1.00/1,000 gallons
Tier Four: 114,801 gallons and over	\$5.00/1,000 gallons	\$5.00/1,000 gallons

* Total Base Water Charge, including Recovery Charges for Residential Water Charges is \$6.00

** Total Base Water Charge, including Recovery Charge for Commercial Water Charges is \$24.50

Upon written request by a Property Owner, BWID will stop the delivery of water at their service meter for temporary periods of time. Fixed Monthly Recovery Charges and Base Rate billings will continue whether or not water delivery service occurs.

Fixed and Additional Charges

- Delinquency Charge for unpaid monthly charges apply after 10 days from billing due date \$2.50
- Interest of 1.5% also applies to past due amounts **Billed as calculated**
- New construction/installation requires Board approval and prepayment of fees and estimated installation costs.
- Administrative Fee for coordination and oversight of installation project \$250.00
- Estimate of installation and connection costs, i.e., special permits, road crossing, installation and excavation equipment, materials, etc.) **Individual Case Basis**
- After completion, but prior to service activation, payment of actual installation costs that exceeded previously paid deposit (if any) **Individual Case Basis**
- Non-Sufficient Fund (NSF) fee for returned check \$35.00
- Restoration of Water Service after shut-off due to Delinquent Payments or Failure to Comply with Rules and Regulations. **Requires advance payment of outstanding charges plus security deposit consisting of two months of minimum monthly charges (Recovery & Base Water Rate)**
- Delinquent Payments \$60.00
- Failure to Comply with Rules and Regulations \$60.00
- Turn on fee \$75.00
- Notary fee \$ 5.00
- Fees for Water Delivered Outside the BWID Boundary to Contractors or for Other Purposes
- Contractor single USE fee of \$50 plus \$2.00 Per 1000 Gallons as Delivered from BWID System
- Contractor seasonal (fixed period of 6 consecutive months) permit fee of \$150 plus \$2.00 Per 1000 Gallons as Delivered from BWID System, upon BWID Approval.

Per BWID's Bylaws: BWID will provide local fire departments a water source for fighting fire in the surrounding area of Southern Wasco County. The water for fire suppression shall be taken from the BWID delivery system at no charge to the fire department. The delivery system includes fire fills, and fire hydrants for use by fire and tanker trucks that are installed and maintained at no charge to the fire department.
